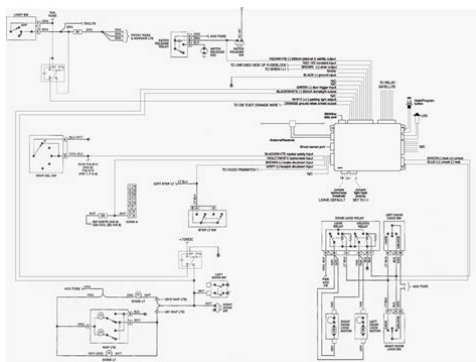

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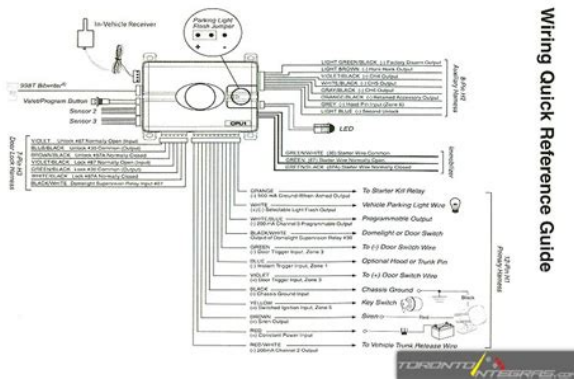

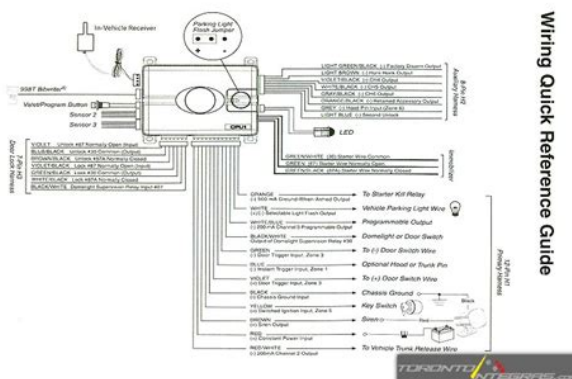

I can not find the valet button for it though. Can anyone help me find it. Not exactly sure what the button looks like. I know it is there because we recently had a remote programmed to it. My problem is I remote started my car, went out to the car and hit the unlock button. The second I hit the unlock button the car shut off and I haven't been able to start the car or get any communications between the remote and the alarm. I checked all the fuses I could find but none are blown. Any ideas I would like at the least to be able to start my car so I can take it in to get looked at once I have time later this week. Thank you I recently purchased a 94 model Nissan 300ZX and I don't know which Viper system is installed. There was a problem or something with the remote but the alarm got activated. The alarm has been screaming its head off so I had to disconnect the battery. The car won't even start with the alarm activated. How on earth do I temporarily disarm the alarm system so that I can start my car!! Where might the valet button be located Or can I disconnect the system. Please advise! To put the unit into valet mode, turn the ignition on and press the valet button which should be under your dash as well, mounted on a plastic panel or ziptied to a wiring harness. If you can't find it, locate the main unit, look for a blue plug with two wires in it and follow it to the switch. Every so often when I start the truck it says on the screen that I need to have my brake system checked and my ABS and EBrake light remain on until I pull away then the lights and warning message goes away. Does anyone know what would be causing this with the Viper 5900 remote start. Thanks for your help! Whoever installed it might not have hooked up all of the wires required to power up the computer in the car and that is why you are getting error codes. For ignition you should have the PINK ignition wire and WHITE 2nd ignition wire and for accessories you should have the ORANGE accessory and BROWN 2nd accessory wires hooked to the remote start. You might not need the BROWN wire but you definitely need to have the WHITE wire hooked up. I'm taking this to the shop who did the install.

I thought if it's an electrical problem the error code should show everytime the truck starts. What do you think Thanks again! So, if the remote start isn't powering everything that it should, it will kick out error codes and then when you turn the key on, the key powers what it's supposed to and clears the codes. It has been at the body shop for a year and now they tell me it doesn't start or get any power. He believes it is related to the alarm. I'd like to not only disarm the alarm but uninstall it altogether. Any advice to get my car started and bypass the alarm. He also said he gets no power to the car whatsoever. Is that an alarm issue Can someone post TechTip 1041 or offer any advice on how to connect the door locks. As I understand, it uses reversing polarity for the locks and I don't know how to interface that. Thanks. I have never heard of an alarm that totally cuts all power only ignition. How can I disarm and uninstall the alarm Thanks To uninstall it, just unplug the wires going to the brain box, follow to wire to where they are connected, cut the wire and tape off the exposed wires in the car. You'll probably have to reconnect the starter wire near the steering column. Just had it installed, but would like to lower the chirp sound. Thanks in advance. I lost one of my remote

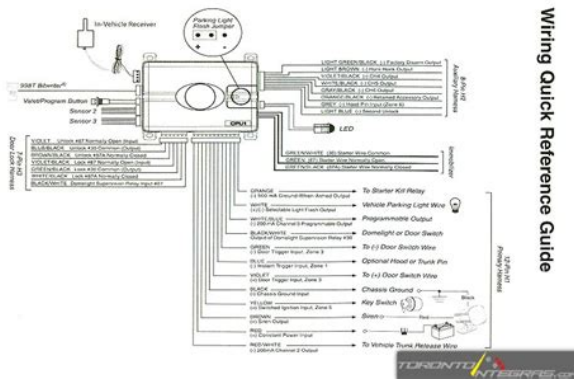
over the weekend so only one original left. So, I purchased a new Viper RPN 476V 266 Codes without any programming instruction. If anyone could help me find the programming instruction manual and if I program the new remote. CAN I STILL USE MY OLD REMOTE WITH THE NEW REMOTE. Thanks I have a diesel truck and I know they hooked up the wire behind the cluster so the alarm would wait to start until the glow plug light turns off. I had some work done and I think they may have reset it by accident. Thanks! What is the model of the Viper system. The number on the remote control is meaningless because you can use the same remote with other systems but the programming of the system is specific.

James DeBello, It sounds like you may have to diode isolate your 791XVs brake input wire. It may be feeding back into the vehicles computer generating the error code. I want to find out what the wires are that my installer gave back to me are and how to add them in when I get the additional components for the trunk release and remote start. I too have problems with my 791xv viper. Ive tried disarming the car with the valet button, but i dont know how many times i have to press the valet button after ignition on, so ive tried 1 time didnt work, ign off then back on try pressing 2 times didnt work. and so on till i got to 5 but it still didnt work. Ive checked all the wiring all is in properly, ive also tried the other functions with the valet button but none seem to work. I am really upset because now i cant drive the car anywhere, cant even start it. Anyone have any suggestions as to what to do. Does the fact that i had door and hood open all the time make any difference when trying to disarm with valet button. Please someone help me! I am wanting to add in the remote start and trunk popper at a later date, but will need the install sheet. At the moment it is armed, and i cannot get it to disarm. I got in the car and did the learn routine, and the alarm went off. I am so annoyed and frustrated its unbelievable Through some investigation I now understand that my vehicle is equipped with a Viper 300 ESP system. I have a LED near my steering column that is always RED. According to the documentation this means that my system is in VALET mode. Unfortunately I do not know how exit VALET mode.

I have checked, and checked, and I do not see a VALET switch anywhere in the vehicle. Today, I stopped by the local VIPER dealer and he gave me a switch for this system free of charge. With what I have told you do you think there is anything I can do to reset my system and or hook up this new VALET switch. I am supposed to see a 1 sec blink on the LED but I do not see it. Instead it is SOLID red. I appreciate any replies I thankyou in advance for your time. This was the thing I needed and now the system performs exactly how it should. I need to get the remote programming sequence from it. I'm trying to find a manual for it but having no luck. Can anyone help me I have read all the previous postings, but could not find any reponses with a direct link for this manual. Thanks Can anyone identify the model. Everything works except the chirps. I have a feeling that I somehow put my viper system on permanent silent mode. Can anyone tell me how to get the chirps back. I REALLY would appreciate it. PLEASE HELP SOMEBODY, i have called every number I can and they keep telling me I am going to have to pay to get someone to look at it. Just in case, heres a link to the installation guide as well The solenoid works fine with the included push button. Im trying to wire it to the AUX button for the keyfob. How should I go about this. I know Ill need a relay, but with what specs MY vehicle is a 2000 Mazda Miata. The car doesnt have any factory alarm and I followed the installation instruction for the alarm. Ive connected the white wire H1white to the wire in that activates the relay for the park lights. The system is configured for negative output on the brain. Both are the same, just newer additional remote is all. PLEASE HELP. Trying to adjust options just had installed by Best Buy and they are no help at the moment. I have great wiring skills, do you think I will be able to get it done with that.

It still works but the siren doesnt work and at this point I want to simply disarm and remove the whole thing. How do I do it I didnt install it and have no idea where things are wired to etc. Please

help. It should look kinda outofplace and say Viper on it. Basically all you have to do is unplug the main unit and reconnect the large yellow wire that was cut on your steering column if you had starterkill installed. If you want to completely remove the wires, just follow each wire to where it is connected to the vehicle wiring, cut it off, and tape up the exposed end of the vehicle wiring. And, are you in the USA or the UK But I have another problem. If the alarms gets triggered by a any door switch the systems LED will flash the corresponding zone that triggered the alarm. It says in the manual that the flashing of the led should be cleared once the ignition is turned on. Unfortunately mine doesnt clear up and it stays blinking trying to display the zone that triggered the alarm.How hard would it be to install this on my own. Thanks everyone I changed the battery on one, now the remote lights work but do not actavate anything. The second remote is fine.Its been a week. My alarm system is the Viper 350HV Basically recently today I accidentally armed my vehicle while I had the door open and ever since then the LED light has been on. It never blinks or anything, it just stays on with the blue color that it should usually flash. I dont know if thats what caused the issue, because I have accidentally armed my vehicle before in the same manner and had no problems at all, so I dont know what is up. Also when I lock and unlock my vehicle it doesnt chirp, so not only does the LED stay on, but the alarm system doesnt chirp when locking and unlocking it. Any answers to this. It should be on the top side of the brain box under the dash of the car. The number on the remote control is just the part number for the remote and is used for several systems. Apparently though while trying to figure out the problem before I just got this I was locking and unlocking my vehicle as I had seen that the light was no longer on anymore and on the passenger side door it sounded as if a motor was running everytime it was unlocked and the sound got higher in pitch as though it was winding up. Could this be part of the same problem Thanks. I am about to have a 3202v Viper installed. I am considering getting a 508d proximity alarm installed with it, or later, not sure yet. However, my question is When the 508d is installed, ideally I would like to be able to fully arm the car without proximity with one button push, and have the proximity used as well with a second button push. Is there a way for the installer to do that. Which way will it work Thanks! Your door lock may just be stuck or getting old. Warren R, The system should be able to bypass a sensor with an additional press of a button right out of the box. Youll have to check your owners manual for details on how to do this. I couldnt find the dang button that they put in there, so that was part of the problem, ha ha. As for the door lock. The issue seemed to clear itself up. I almost thought it was a messed up sylanoid, because my truck is a basically brand new 06 silverado with hardly any miles and engine time on it, so I doubted it was a door issue. Thanks again though! What feature or how do i program a feature to make it so the first time the button is pushed it only unlocks the drivers, and then the others Its not a simple programming change, its an actual install modification. My dads pretty good with it. My battery recently went bad.

I replaced battery and now when I advance the key to engage starter, seems all power is cut to vehicle. I now only see 6 volts on the hot wire to viper harness and alarm is barely audible. I can disconnect, then reconnect battery alarm goes crazy. I disable alarm with remote, turn key to engage starter same thing happens. I have removed the battery, starter and alternator all check good. How can I isolate the vehicle electical system from the viper so I can troubleshoot the problem without the alarm intervening. Any help is appreciated! This alarm came with the car I cant get to the brain cuz whoever installed it was very crafty and flexible. So i was able to do the over ride with the ignition key and door open no start, did the valet trick no start. Please any suggestions were

moving out this week and need to be out by 31 July, thanks for any other suggestions. If it still does not turn over with this wire reconnected, you may have an immobilizer issue with the car. Start with the wire and let me know what happens. I was able to isolate the alarm from the car electronics and quickly discovered a bad ground. All is well. Thanks again. Thanks Kyle The information you are looking for is on page 34 under Diagnostics Computers 2,549 Laptops, Car Audio 255 Head Units. The car automatically locks doors within 5 secs of ignition on, and have locked myself out with car running twice. Toyota says that Autolock is NOT their feature so it must be the Rattler. I have no idea where the valet switch is either. I went to the Viper site, and I see an owners guide for Viper 300 which takes you to a Viper Model 300 pdf, and a Rattler 300 which takes you to a Model 431R pdf. Is there a difference. Car is currently Active alarming, and we DO NOT use it, as sometimes my wife cant disarm it. However HOW can I shut off the Autolock. Its worked great for the past four years. Now there is no alarm anymore.

Ive looked through the installation and owners manual there was nothing to explain this. Is it possible my siren speaker is dead. Could be, but then that doesnt explain why the car horn does not sound as well. Im stumped. Any help on how to exit this mode or solve the problem would help. PS I have no idea where the valet switch is hidden in the car. Haha, Anyways. I am going to buy the Viper 1000 with the voice mod and the invisabeam addon. It has a manual transmission and has power door locks, thanks to my being bored. Will this system work aight on my truck ALSO. I wanna hook up the remote starter, where the heck is my neutral wire. Can i make the viper system turn on my ignition, and nothing more. I want to buy it, and Im planning to install it myself, but before buying it, I think I should read what I will face through installation, and if too difficult Id rather ask them to install it for me. Instead they suggested that Id rather buy a Med [www.meditaly.com](http://www.meditaly.com) alarm that installs directly in a way on the ECU and is controlled through the stock key of the car. What is your opinion on this matter. Could the Viper 5000 cause any problem on my car. Maybe interfering with the CAN bus wires, etc. Do you think they told me all those just to make me buy their product. Also, what is your opinion about the specific Viper 500 model. I think it is a decent solution since it has a builtin Comfort control device. And since I am not interested in Remote start or Turbo timer functions although my car is a turbocharged one, I think that the 5000 is just fine for me. I also plan to equip it with the following accessories 508D Invisibeam Field Disturbance Sensor 506T Audio Sensor, and a 520T Backup battery. Is there any installation guide for the first two sensors Does it matter what input zone I will connect each of those two sensors to. Thanks in advance for your reply. I had it installed by a dealer in my area. Is it only for Trunk release which I dont have.

How do I secure my trunk with this wire if possible I changed the battery and now it doesnt turn the alarm off. I have to bypass the alarm for the past couple of days manually and its really annoying. Is there a program for the remote that I could get. Thanks. I also bought a 506T audio sensor, a 507T tilt sensor, and a 508D field disturbance sensor. However, Im totally confused about how Im gonna connect them on the alarm. Finally, on the left side of the alarm there are two ports mentioned in the installation manual of the alarm as Sensor 2 and Sensor 3. The question is this What options do I have in connecting the three sensors. Ideally, I would need 3 multiplexed inputs beside the Zone 2 multiplexed input for the builtin shock sensor. So now, will I have to share one multiplexed input on two sensors. And which sensors make sense to share the same input. Please try to give me a general guideline on my question. Thank you in advance for any answer, and I am sorry for the long post. And for those that have either of these systems, are you relatively happy. A dealer atempted to program 2 remotes but they would not take. According to his crossreference guide the only listing for a 300ESP remote includes a date code of 9A and up. My brain has a date code of 2G. Any ideas All the remotes listed for that date code are nonhopping and nonHF. According to the install manual that was left in the car the 300ESP has both of those features. The authorized dealer and my self are clueless. Thanks in advance for your help. Thought I would add that he was able to get into programming mode. He also traced the antenna to make sure it was connected. The alarm has just 2



multiplexed side ports, in which I have to connect the 3 sensors I mentioned. However, after some study on the sensors, I saw that only 508D is a twostate sensor warn away, and full alarm. The other two, 506T and 507T, are instantly triggered.

What do you think Should I connect the 508D on a multiplexed side port, and have the other two ones share the second side port. If so, does it matter which of the two sensors triggers will go to each of the two trigger pins of the port. Is that correct Finally, after some tests I performed, I saw that the responders screen will not recognise the three sensors in order to blink the appropriate icon upon their triggering. It just blinks the number of the zone that is triggered, i.e. zone 4 or zone 7. Is there a way to somehow register each sensor so that the correct icon blinks on the responder How can I get this thing to go back silent where the lights just flash I have the install guide and have read the section on remotes. Do I push the valet switch once and then push and hold it and the lock button on the remote with the remote selected to vehicle two When I bought it, the car dealership threw in a Viper alarm. I do not have the manual. Thanks if anyone knows. christy It has functioned perfectly until yesterday After working flawlessly through Friday evening, I noticed yesterday morning that it seemed sluggish in responding to my transmitter. It would take a few tries before the alarm would arm or disarm, although it eventually worked. However, by the evening, it had lost almost all functionality. When I came out to my car late at night the transmitter would not work at all, and I was stuck out of my car. By some stroke of luck my girlfriend got one last signal out of the transmitter to disarm the alarm, and the transmitter has been functionless ever since. At this point, all the local dealers are closed because it is Sunday. Is there anything I can do to remedy this situation without waiting for a dealer. I did not install it myself. I thought maybe my new radar detector could have been causing some sort of interference, but even with the detector powered off and several feet from the car, the transmitter still failed to work. Help!

I wonder whats the point of this forum anymore. Just asking questions and receive no answer. I really wonder why we still visit this site to contribute to its popularity, if we dont get answers to our problems. Any help and I am grateful.Or is everyone asking questions. I have the same questions as Peter K, trying to hook up optional sensors on a DEI alarm. No documentation for this process. Would like to use the icons on my LCD remote. Should this forum just go away, if it doesnt help anyone to post questions here Which would be better for a Jeep Wrangler the Viper 5000 or the 790xv. Everything is working excepted unlock passenger and 2 back doors. I can get driver side open every single time with 1 push. With 2 pushes and hold to get other doors open, it only works 2 out of 5 times. I brought it back twice. Bestbuy said nothing else they can do. They try to connect power wire from passenger side door, then every time I push the remote once, it open all doors instead of driver side door only. Thats not right. Anyone has any ideas or why. To me, it sound like it is trying to open, but it doesnt have enough power to it. Anyhow, thanks whole lots first. I have looked all under the dash and glovebox and i cant find anything. The reason I need to find it is because the alarm started going off one day when I was not home. It eventually died when the battery died I guess.

But now nothing works, the remote, the siren, or anything in the car. I was thinking if I just pulled the brain out and rewired the correct wire to the starter, the car would start, it seemes the alarm is fried. Any help would be greatly appreciated. Thank you. The engine turns over, but doesnt start.Any one know My remote can only goes about 200ft when I try to remote start. I am about to buy another

Where is the problem, and can it be resolved Does anyone out there have any they would be interested in selling Thank you, Smokn PS Here is a photo of the specific remote unit! Ive had it for 5 years without a problem. A couple months ago I was involved in a front end collision which destroyed the Viper siren. My insurance company put on a generic siren which was definitely louder. Five weeks after I get my car back with the generic siren working just fine, problems started happening. My siren will go off everytime the headlights are on. Its not as loud as if the siren was tripped, but still noticeable.

When I arm or disarm my car, my headlights blink with the brain. Everytime my headlights blink, you hear the sirens faint yelp. Does anyone know why this is happening. I dont think its a bad siren because I hooked up the siren to a 12V battery and its loud and works fine. Could this generic siren damage the 550 brain. Any input would be great. I hate driving at night now because my alarm is always sounding. CTRLF searches the forum, that manual has been posted at least 12 times that I count. Search for 791xv, the link is in this post! Ive tried putting the key into the on position and holding the valet button, but with no success. If so, am I screwed. Or would disssconnecting the battery, then reconnecting it turn off the system and let me drive the car. I have a 98 Ford Mustang with a stock alarm. I couldnt find my valet button and my alarm was stuck in valet mode. Just like these guys said; open the driver door, switch the key to on, then off, and hit button I, button II, and then button I again and the alarm will exit valet mode. Cool beans. Experiment if it doesnt work for you. I have it from the mid 90s and it has all the good stuff like windows, and hatch pop, and locks, prox sesor but i need a install to put it in a new car. Now I hear they can post them online any more so i wonder if anyone has one I think the alarm system stops the car from cranking. There is no way i can disarm the system by using my 2way remote. Plus, i was trying to find my valet button. However, I cant make sure the one I found is my valet switch. Even if the one I found is the right one, I followed the users guide to disarm the system and seems like it doesnt work. Can someone help me on that.Does anyone how to program it for the powered rear hatch. The AUX opens the sliding door.the STAR does the remote start.
